SEDGEFIELD

Mixed feedback from bookmakers, with cautious optimism based on recommenced trading since track work, with some disappointment also expressed.

In 2024 there will be 18 fixtures. Highlights include: Cheltenham Raceday Tuesday 12 March; Gents Aintree Raceday on Friday 12 April; Ladies evening on Friday 10 May; New season Opener Monday 23 September, Durham National Sunday 20 October; Festive Jumper Raceday Friday 6 December and finally the Boxing Day Fixture.

There will be two specific Students racedays – Friday 26 January and Friday 6 December.

Racecourse management is targeting an increase in public attendance with social media marketing and other activities throughout the year. A suggestion was made to have another local residents race meeting. CS agreed to consider.

Advance online public admission will start at £13. The online booking fee has been discontinued.

Bookmakers asked that the unsightly bank of redundant TV screens which face into the betting ring are covered/decorated over - CS.

NEWCASTLE

Similar feedback from bookmakers as to that for Sedgefield, with Feature Meetings being in the main very good. All agreed the standard AW meetings were a challenge.

For 2024 there will be 78 meetings, 65 being AW.

There will be 10 Feature Meetings: New Year's Day; 24 Feb Eider Chase; 16 March St Patrick's Day/Cheltenham Raceday; 29 March AW Final; 13 April GN Raceday; 27 June Sefton Trophy Day; 28 June Gosforth Park Cup Night; 29 June Northumberland Plate; 27 July

Ladies Day; 1 November Fireworks & Funfair; 30 November Fighting Fifth; 14 December Christmas Jumper.

Three Student Racedays are planned. The local Postcode race meeting will take place on a Sunday.
